

Stenciling Instructions



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Read ALL Steps BEFORE proceeding

Materials Needed: Blue etching stencils, etching crème, spray bottle filled with water, damp sponge or paper towel

1. Clean the window area to be etched.

Recommended stencil locations:

- Bottom right-hand corner of front and rear windshields,
- Bottom corner of door windows, directly above door handles,
- Corner of any rear window, t-top, or sunroof.

2. Separate and peel one blue stencil tissue from its backing paper.
3. Position stencil on the glass making sure it is level and right side up.
4. Gently press the stencil tissue flat to smooth any wrinkles.
5. Carefully dab etching crème over the numbers on the stencil tissue.
6. Avoid applying the solution too close to the edge of the stencil tissue. Any contact with the glass surface will result in an etch.
7. Wait 2 - 3 minutes and carefully peel off the blue stencil tissue and discard.
8. **IMMEDIATELY** spray etch area with water to neutralize the etching crème.
9. Wipe well with a damp sponge or paper towel.
10. Repeat steps for each window.

YOUR STENCIL JOB IS NOW COMPLETE

Avoid applying in wet, windy, or dusty conditions. In cold weather, the etching process may take slightly longer. Over-etching causes “fuzziness” effect and bolder image.



Helpful Hints:

1. Wear a good pair of safety glasses that fit well and are comfortable.
2. Use disposable latex or chemical resistant gloves.

WARNING: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Caution should be used when handling etch crème. Harmful if swallowed. Prolonged contact on the skin may cause burns which may not be immediately painful or visible.

- If swallowed, **DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING:** Drink large quantities of water followed by milk.
- For Skin Contact: Wash with soap & water for 5 minutes.
- For Eye Contact: Flush with water for 15 minutes.
